The subject open item (No. 24 as listed in Chapter 1 of the SER) consists of two requirements. The first part, dealing with financial protection & indemnity required for preoperational storage of fuel, was addressed in the referenced letter.

The purpose of this letter is to commit LP&L to the second requirement, that being to provide the Commission with proof of the required financial protection so that an indemnity agreement appropriate to reactor operation may be issued. This evidence will be provided prior to the anticipated issuance of the operating license.
