Gentlemen:

Consistent with the Applicant's policy of full disclosure, I am enclosing a copy of a report prepared by Touche Ross & Co. for the Oklahoma Corporation Commission in connection with a pending rate case filed by Public Service Company of Oklahoma ("PSO"). The summary of the report's conclusions is set forth on pages 10-13. One of these judgments suggests that, based on Touche Ross' cost assessment and development, the Black Fox Station project should be converted from a nuclear to a coal facility.

All aspects of the report are being carefully evaluated and considered by PSO, and its assessment will be presented to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.



Applicant has filed today, under separate cover, Amendment No. 16 to the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report for its construction permit application for the Black Fox Station. Amendment No. 16 addresses the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's post-TMI regulations concerning emergency planning. Applicant expects to file Amendment No. 17 to the Preliminary Safety Analysis Report by October 5, 1981. This Amendment will address the NRC's recent amendments to 10 C.F.R. Part 50 which are applicable to all pending near-term construction permit applications like Black Fox Station.
