Gentlemen:

In our proposed Technical Specifications submitted in our January 30, 1981 letter, the term "hot standby" was used when "hot shutdown" was the proper term. Also, there was an inconsistency in the required time for shutdown of the reactor in the case of inoperable cooling units or spray systems. Specifically, in section 3.3.7.D, if two cooler groups were inoperable both of them must be in an operable status within 7 days or be in hot shutdown; however, in section 3.3.7.F, if a cooler unit fan is inoperable the cooling unit must be operable within 72 hours. This is a more restrictive requirement for a less severe condition.

The attached Technical Specifications correct these oversights for ANO-1 and also correct a similar inconsistency in time limits for ANO-2.

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
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MEMBER MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES SYSTEM




