Dear Mr. Gorsline:

This refers to the license amendment request dated October 10, 2019 from NSF International, NRC License No. 21-15209-02. Based on the letter, we understood that you requested to name Ms. Kogelschatz as a new Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and authorized user for all licensed material, and to remove Mr. Williams listed as the RSO and authorized user from the license. As a result of the review, we determined that additional information will be needed to complete this licensing action. Please provide the following information for the proposed RSO, Ms. Andrea Kogelschatz.

- 1) Education: at a minimum a B.S. degree in engineering or science or equivalent
- 2) Work experience: hands-on training with radioactive material related to the licensed material and use authorized in NRC License No. 21-15209-02 (including, the radionuclides (Ra-226, Tr-90, Pu-239, etc.), physical forms (sealed source, unsealed, volatile, dispersible, etc.), quantities handled (microcuries, millicuries, etc.), activities performed (assay, labeling, spiking samples with liquid radioactive material for calibration purposes, etc.), duration of experience (3 months, a year, etc.)
- 3) Experience with RSO duties based on the scope of the radiation safety program (radiation survey, dosimetry, bioassay, radiation control, contamination control, licensed material inventory and security, radiation safety program audit, radiation survey instrument calibration, radioactive waste disposal, emergency response, duration of experience, etc.)

Please provide a response by December 18, 2019 and please indicate Mail Control No. 616192 in the response to facilitate proper mail handling in our office. You could fax the response with a cover letter signed and dated by the licensee management to 630-515-1078.
