I am responding to your letter dated September 26, 2019, which requested that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) re-approve Truck Route No. 249, which is scheduled to expire March 17, 2020. Route No. 249 is used for transporting spent nuclear fuel.

The NRC has reviewed your application and concluded that the information you provided dated September 26, 2019, with supplemental information provided on December 11, 2019, satisfies the requirements of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Section 73.37. This letter constitutes approval. The approved route is now designated as Truck Route No. 249A and will expire January 31, 2025. The NRC expects your periodic review and update of the emergency telephone numbers associated with this route. Changes to emergency contact numbers do not qualify as a route deviation or change.
