- c. No decisions regarding the merits of this petition will be made at this meeting.
- d. The meeting will be transcribed and the transcript will be made publicly available.
- e. No sensitive or proprietary information should be presented.
- f. Following this meeting, the PRB will consider the supplemental information presented during the meeting together with the original petition in making its final recommendation on whether to accept the petition for review. The petitioner will be informed of the final recommendation.
