
Subject: **Global Laser Enrichment Commercial Facility Integrated Safety Analysis Summary  
Annual Update for SNM-2019**

Dear Mr. Lubinski:

The requirements in 10 CFR 70.72(d)(3), call for licensees to submit to NRC annually, within 30 days after the end of the calendar year during which the changes occurred, revised Integrated Safety Analysis (ISA) Summary pages. The purpose of this letter is to inform the NRC that GE Hitachi Global Laser Enrichment LLC (GLE) has not made changes to the ISA Summary since the initial license for the GLE Commercial Facility (SNM-2019) was issued on September 25, 2012. Therefore, GLE will not be submitting revised pages. The Commercial Facility license SNM-2019 is being held in abeyance, until GE plans on building the facility. Any changes needed to keep the license current with the regulations will be reviewed and updated as appropriate prior to construction.
