

- a. Site clearing and grading - scheduled to begin on or about January 12, 1983.
- b. Road to Gate Well - scheduled to begin on or about January 27, 1983.
- c. Gate Well Construction - scheduled to begin after March 1, 1983.
- d. Canal crossing for construction access and canal dewatering - scheduled to begin on or about January 21, 1983.
- e. River access and piping for canal pumping - scheduled to begin on or about February 8, 1983.
- f. Intake line from Gate Well; to canal and to pumphouse - scheduled to begin after March 1, 1983.
- g. Excavation for pumphouse - scheduled to begin on or about January 27, 1983.
- h. Stockpile excavated material - scheduled to begin on or about January 27, 1983.
- i. Pumphouse structure - scheduled to begin after March 1, 1983.
- j. Transmission main from pumphouse to Bradshaw Reservoir - scheduled to begin on or about January 26, 1983.
