Gentlemen:

This letter documents the telephone conversation on August 18, 1982, between Messrs. R. Warnick, D. Hunter, W. Little of the NRC and H. R. Sager, B. R. Sylvia, J. Shaffer and C. W. Vincent of CG&E.

It was agreed that the "Immediate Action Letter" issued by the Commission on December 24, 1980, and CG&E's Stop Work Order #80-14 applied only to material, equipment and labor supplied by Reactor Controls Inc. This understanding resulted in CG&E's modification of Stop Work Order #82-01 (copy attached), releasing Catalytic, Inc. to perform new work resulting from the Sargent & Lundy reanalysis of the CRD Piping System, except where such new work would adversely affect the ability to evaluate and correct the material, equipment and/or labor supplied by Reactor Controls Inc.
