1. The Board erred in limiting the scope of the reopened record to only the emergency evacuation brochure in the Board Memorandum and Order of October 18, 1982.

2. The Board erred in not allowing the testimony of Earl Duncan to be incorporated into the record of the hearing.

3 The Board erred in not giving any weight to Joint Intervenor witness Dr. Saundra Hunter.

4. The Board erred in finding that the Applicant's brochure is not intended as a motivational tool. (FF 4 - 6)

5. The Board erred in finding that the opening sentence in the panel captioned "A Message to Our Neighbors and Friends" will not seriously diminish the credibility of the brochure. (FF 1 - 3)

6. The Board erred in finding the section captioned "Radiation Emergencies" would cause no confusion.
(FF 7 - 9)


7. The Board erred in finding that the section captioned "What Radiation Is" contains inaccuracies that are inconsequential and adequately informs the public about the nature of radiation. (FF 10 - 11)

8. The Board erred in finding that the reading level was adequate and that the 10% of the population that could not understand this document would be informed in other ways. (FF 13 - 18)

9. The Board erred in allowing any inclusion into this hearing record of information concerning the "Special Needs Information Card" since it had been ruled out of the scope of this hearing.
