Dear Ms. Woodhead and Mr. Cormier:


As per the Board's April 7, 1983, Order, pre-filed testimony for the upcoming inherent safety hearings is to be in the parties' hands on June 15.

We expect the remaining qualifications to be immediately provided, and will tolerate no similar delay in the receipt of the prefiled testimony.
