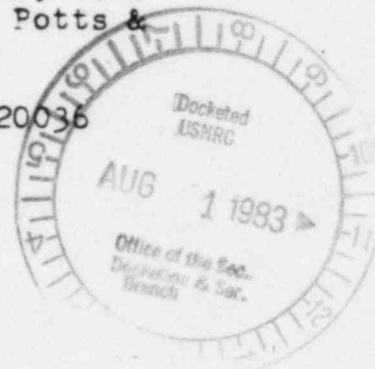

Dear Tom Baxter,

July 29 1983

Your letter of July 27, received this afternoon, is somewhat in contrast to your nice touch in sending me a copy of CLI 83-19. In our talk of the 25th you mentioned not getting the 7/20 filing and I said I'd send you an extra. You said you would take 14 days from receipt of the extra to respond. I said that was fine and if you needed more time, just ask. You said you didn't need any more time.

Now I get this letter saying you'll "treat" the filing as if mailed 7/25. I'll be glad to give you 3 more days, or however much more time you need. But I think this letter in contradiction of your position on the phone, in this minor matter, is a symptom of a perhaps larger problem (as also seen in our prehearing conference of 2/24): you don't seem to remember oral agreements that well. That's the only reason I'm sending this reply, as I'll be glad to give you more time. You never questioned that the 7-20 filing was mailed to Applicants, truly, Wells Eddleman
