Enclosed herewith are forty (40) copies of the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station Licensed Operator Regualification Program (10 CFR 55, Appendix A) for your review and approval. This document submittal, which was previously discussed with members of your Staff, includes:

Regualification Training Schedule - Attachment III

The referenced program is based on an operations schedule utilizing a six (6) crew shift rotation, with the individual crews designated as "A" through "F". One (1) week regualification training sessions are conducted for six (6) consecutive weeks, with each crew rotating into the training schedule for their respective scheduled period. Classroom schedule is based on a five (5) day, forty (40) hour training week with the exception of weeks 83-1 and 83-3, which were offered as four (4) day, thirty-two (32) hour training periods. All license holders attend two (2) weeks per year of Simulator Training, Sessions 83-2 and 83-7, which include thirty (30) hours of simulator time per week for a total of sixty (60) hours per year. Simulator training is conducted at the


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Limerick Simulator. Annual requalification examinations, written and oral, are scheduled to be conducted during November and December, 1983 and January, 1984. Portions of the Shift Technical Advisor training program includes attending the Operator Re-qualification Training special topics sessions. These dates are shown on the schedule.
