
Subject: NUCLEAR PROJECT NO. 1
REQUIRED ACTIONS BASED ON GENERIC
IMPLICATIONS OF SALEM ATWS EVENTS

References: 1) NRC Generic Letter 83-28, dated July 8, 1983
2) Supply System Letter, G.D. Bouchey to Harold R. Denton,
NRC, "Construction Permit Extension WNP-1,"
dated January 11, 1983.

Reference 1 requested that within 120 days we provide projected dates for the implementation of the items enclosed with the reference. (The WNP-1 operating license application is before the NRC).

In view of the extended WNP-1 construction delay discussed in reference 2, we plan to provide the requested dates upon construction restart. This would be at least three years prior to fuel load. As discussed in reference 2, the earliest date for fuel load is June 1, 1988.

It should be understood that with construction of WNP-1 currently in suspension, we will not be making any additions to the plant prior to restart that will make any hardware changes required by reference 1 more difficult.
