
Gentlemen:

We have reviewed IE Bulletin 83-05, "ASME Nuclear Code Pumps and Spare Parts Manufactured by the Hayward Tyler Pump Company". Although Beaver Valley Power Station Unit 1 was not identified as a user of Hayward Tyler pumps in Attachment 1 of the Bulletin, a review was performed to identify any safety-related Hayward Tyler pumps installed at our facility. Based on our review, we have determined that Unit 1 has not utilized any pumps or spare parts manufactured by the Hayward Tyler Pump Company in safety-related applications.

Our estimate of the manpower expended in conducting the review and preparing this response is 60 manhours.
