Response to I&E Inspection 50-336/83-07

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, this report is submitted in reply to Reference (4).

Reference (4) informed the Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) that further clarifying information would assist the timely resolution of the subject apparent item of non-compliance. References (1), (2), and (3) are previous correspondence related to this matter. In Reference (4), the NRC agreed that Figure 6.2-2 of the Technical Specifications, as revised by Amendment 54, properly represents the services organization, and is in full compliance with Technical Specification 6.2.2.

The NRC was informed that Administrative Control Procedure ACP-QA-1.02, titled Organization and Responsibilities, specifies that the Radiological Services Supervisor fulfills the responsibilities of the Radiation Protection Manager. The Radiological Services Supervisor reports directly to the Station Services Superintendent.


Therefore, the NRC's original concern that the Radiation Protection Manager did not report to a sufficiently high level of station management, had been previously addressed by station management.

By Reference (4) the NRC requested that NNECO submit a change to Millstone Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications, Section 6, Paragraph 6.3.1. The change will replace the title "Health Physics Supervisor" with "Radiation Protection Manager". Be advised that we intend to submit this change without an amendment fee, by invoking footnote (2) of 10CFR170.22. Should the Licensee Fee Management Branch question whether the forthcoming amendment request is based upon "a written commission request for the application," we will refer them to your office and the Reference (4) conversation.

Since the NRC's concern, which formed the basis for the item of non-compliance, was precluded from occurring by Administrative Control Procedures, and because NRC Inspection Reports and Notices of Violation become public information, NNECO requests that this apparent violation be formally rescinded.
