Your letter (Reference 1) of May 5, 1983 transmitted the subject inspection report. MP&L responded to Violation No. 416/83-10-05 on June 6, 1983 (Reference 2).

Your Mr. Paul Fredrickson asked for clarification of three portions of the above discussed response.

Paragraph I: The terminology "lesser included" means lower-tier.

Paragraph IV: "Major controls" means the Temporary Alteration Program in its entirety. This program was felt to be operating in effective manner to control temporary alteration activities.

Paragraph IV: "Other recommendations" means the recommendations provided in Quality Assurance Monitoring Audit Report MAR-83/0055. These recommendations were being evaluated but were not to be construed as commitments.


