

Reference 2 states that even though MCHFR limits are met, power would be reduced at the end of Cycle 3 unless additional analysis was done. As stated, this condition existed because of concern that MCPR may have been limiting if MCPR calculations were performed. Since Cycle 3 calculations bound Cycle 4 conditions, the MCHFR in Cycle 4 is more conservative than the acceptable value calculated for Cycle 3. Also, because Cycle 4 analysis of MCPR has shown acceptable results (see Section 6.3.3.2.1), there is no need to consider an end-of-cycle power restriction in Cycle 4 as was discussed for Cycle 3.

Cycle 4 operation may therefore proceed under the existing Technical Specifications with full assurance of conservative adherence to all limits. This conclusion can be drawn from extensive analysis using both the Hensch-Levy and the GETAB/GEXL heat flux correlations.
