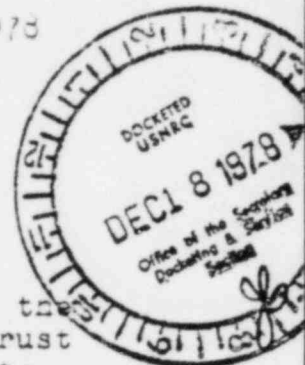
If it is possible for me to continue to get mailings on the case, I would appreciate it. I am very interested in what happens.


