

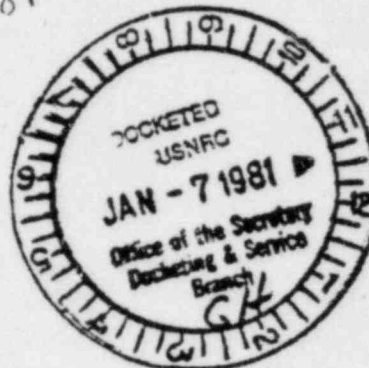




Dear Mr. Lazo:

In reference to Docket Numbers 50-369 and 50-370, I have been retained to be co-counsel with Jesse L. Riley for the Carolina Environmental Study Group (CESG). Since CESG's budget is limited, and I continue to work predominantly for the Labor Law Center, all parties should continue to serve Mr. Riley with all documents, but should serve me additionally. I believe I have a set of all documents accumulated to date, which bear on the forthcoming hearings Ordered by the Board on November 25, 1980. I am, however, sending a request to Ed Ketchen for some NUREG's and papers which Mr. Riley does not have duplicate copies of. As in my prior work with CESG, our intention is to have my legal knowledge supplement Mr. Riley's technical and legal knowledge. We hope that this combination will enable us to move up from the typical intervenors position in which the ability to contribute to the safety of the public is limited by lack of funds.

As stated in prior filings with the NRC, I am licensed in North Carolina as an attorney, have trial, appellate and administrative experience and meet whatever other qualifications are necessary to practice before a licensing Board.
