RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, the Massachusetts Public Interest Research Group (MASSPIRG) requests the following documents concerning the consequences of serious reactor accidents at Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, Plymouth, Massachusetts:

1. Any and all preliminary CRAC [Calculation of Reactor Accident Consequences] results obtained by the NRC Staff for the Pilgrim site; and
2. Any and all final CRAC results obtained by the NRC Staff for the Pilgrim Site.

In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive copying charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public." MASSPIRG is a non-profit public interest organization funded by the contributions of over 20,000 citizens and 10,000 students. MASSPIRG has researched emergency planning for Pilgrim Station for five years, has testified before the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on the emergency plans for the Plymouth area, and currently is preparing written comments for FEMA on those plans.
