

IE BULLETIN 79-14
SEISMIC ANALYSIS FOR AS-BUILT SAFETY RELATED PIPING SYSTEM
NORTH ANNA UNIT 3

IE Bulletin No. 79-14 was issued on July 2, 1979, revised on July 18, 1979, and supplemented on August 15 and September 7, 1979. A letter, Serial No. 552/070279, dated August 1, 1979, was submitted to the Commission as Virginia Electric and Power Company's complete response to IE Bulletin 79-14 for North Anna Units 3 and 4. On October 15, 1979, the Virginia Electric and Power Company announced that it was undertaking a feasibility study of North Anna Units 3 & 4. During this time, all further work on IE Bulletins was deferred, pending the outcome of the study, since one of the studies objectives was to determine if North Anna 3&4 should be continued as nuclear units. Upon completion of the study, it was determined that North Anna 4 would be cancelled and North Anna 3 continued as a nuclear unit. Based on our analysis following the completion of the feasibility study, we have determined that the response given in letter Serial No. 552/070279, requires revision. With the assistance of our engineer and nuclear steam system supplier, we are developing our revised response to this bulletin.

Our revised response to IE Bulletin 79-14 is scheduled for November 15, 1982.
