On August 20, 1982 your office was notified of a reportable occurrence involving loss of electric power to valve CCW-8. Reportable Occurrence Report RO-289/82-15, providing details of this incident was to have been submitted to you by September 21, 1982. A review and evaluation has been performed on the operability of valve CCW-8. The review has determined that valve CCW-8 was operable, in that it was capable of performing its safety related function, and no further action is required. Hence, it is considered that this occurrence is without safety significance and is not reportable.
