
In response to Reference 1, attached is a schedule for providing the information you requested. This information will be used in your post-implementation review of the FitzPatrick Post Accident Sampling System.

- Note 1. For the purpose of this submittal, the information requested has been divided into two portions - Phase I and Phase II.
- Note 2. Analytical times will be provided as part of the Phase II submittal.
- Note 3. Information on predicted personnel exposures for sample analysis will be provided as part of the Phase II submittal.

Phase I - The availability of this information is associated with the installation of the system. System installation is scheduled for March 31, 1983. This information will be provided thirty days after the system is installed. (Refer to: i. J.P. Bayne to D.B. Vassallo letter dated August 9, 1982 (JPN-82-68) and; ii. J.P. Bayne to D.B. Vassallo letter dated August 23, 1982 (JPN-82-70) for revised installation schedule.)
