

Concerning Procurement of ASME Section III Materials

Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to withdraw the request for relief concerning procurement of American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME) Section III materials. The Reference transmitted a request for relief from ASME Section XI IWA-7210 and the resulting administrative and quality requirements of Section III NA-3700/NCA-3800 which preclude Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) from qualifying and procuring materials from material manufacturers and material suppliers who do not hold a Quality Systems Certificate. WCNOC is withdrawing this request for relief based on a decision to pursue an ASME Section III NPT Certificate of Authorization. Withdrawal of the request for relief was discussed on September 12, 1990 between Mr. H. K. Chernoff, WCNOC and Mr. D. V. Pickett, Project Manager, Project Directorate IV.
