2. TVA letter to NRC dated January 18, 1990

In the referenced letters, TVA provided its response to an NRC violation associated with design control. The example cited dealt with cable routing. As a result of the violation, TVA committed to a long-term cable routing program. The second referenced letter extended the commitment completion date to March 1, 1991. Although TVA regards timeliness in implementing NRC commitments to be a primary objective, this commitment will be delayed because of demand on resources unforeseen at the time of scheduling. Resources originally allocated to complete this program were redirected to support the recent SQN electrical distribution system functional inspection. For this reason, completion of the program will be delayed until March 18, 1991. The revised commitment is contained in the enclosure.

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
