Thank you for this opportunity to comment.

I sincerely believe, for multiple complex and technologically critical reasons, that a generic EIS is absolutely a dangerous path to follow regarding any nuclear energy or research proposals. Nuclear is vastly different from any other type of project proposal - there are too many risk factors, too many security issues, too many vectors unaccounted for that could lead to catastrophe.

I recommend that no nuclear proposals ever be granted anything less than a full and in-depth environmental impact statement, and recommend that full-blown EIR requirements be imposed, instead.
