Mr. Williams, I have reviewed your Financial Assurance Documents and have no further questions on the following:

- Letter of Credit
- Decommissioning Cost Estimate
- Standby Trust Agreement
- Schedules to Standby Trust Agreement

I have also reviewed your revised Certification of Financial Assurance (CFA) and noted the following discrepancies when compared to your NRC license (Amendment #29):

- The statement "I certify that MedStar-Georgetown...is licensed to possess the following types and quantities of sources" does not fully describe that unsealed byproduct material and sealed sources are possessed. Consider revising statement to: "I certify that MedStar-Georgetown Medical Center Inc., dba MedStar Georgetown University Hospital is licensed to possess the following types and quantities of unsealed byproduct material and sealed, plated, or foil sources"
- The amount listed for unsealed byproduct material in the first block does not include the possession limit per radionuclide. Consider revising amount to state "1 curie per radionuclide and 15 curies total"
- The sources listed for 3-83 should state 1-83 in the second item listed under Type of Material. Please correct.
- The sources listed for 84-104 should state 84-103 in the third item listed under Type of Material. Please correct.
- Please remove "by U.S. Bank National Association" from the bottom of the CFA since Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. is the issuing entity for the Letter of Credit.
- Please ensure that the revised CFA submitted to address the above items includes signatures and titles of officials of your institution, your corporate seal, and the date.
