Below is the proposed license amendment change, amendment 55, for Materials License SUA-1471, license condition (LC) 35 as part of the Zeolite License Amendment Request. LC's 35 A, B, C, D, will not change. LC 35E will change to add the zeolite water treatment system. Current LC 35E will become LC 35F.

RECOMMENDED LICENSE CHANGES

35. The licensee shall implement a groundwater compliance monitoring program to assess the performance of the groundwater restoration program. This program is separate from the requirements in License Condition 15. The Licensee shall:

A. Unchanged

B. Unchanged

C. Unchanged

D. Unchanged

E. Operate the zeolite water treatment systems located on the Large Tailings Pile as described in the December 11, 2017, February 22, 2018, and May 17, 2019, submittals, including all monitoring and mitigation requirements specified therein.

F. Submit by March 31 of each year, a performance review of the corrective action program that details the progress towards attaining groundwater

protection standards.
