Dear Commissioner Palladino,

I am writing to let you know that I am very concerned about the granting of a full-power license of the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant. I do not think that the plant has been adequately constructed, nor have reasonable evacuation plans been designed should a nuclear accident occur. Please consider these matters carefully since a premature licensing of this plant would jeopardize the health and even the lives of many people. We just don't need the expensive nuclear power generated from the Diablo Plant, unless the safety of those living near it can be assured. I urge you to be cautious in granting the full-power license.
