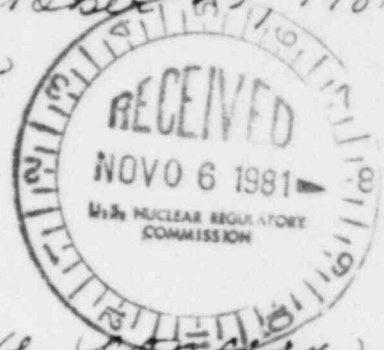

Dear Commission members:

I write out of a grave concern about your consideration of the San Onofre plant's licensure. Nuclear power has proven to be mismanaged, economically unsound, and fraught with problems that extend far into the future. The San Onofre plant in particular, operated 22% of 1980 and yet had more serious incidents than any other reactor in the country.

You have been charged with regulating an industry. Each of you has the choice: whether to serve your country by taking responsibility and pointing out the shortcomings in such a plant, refusing to license a sham — or, you can bow to the pressures of businesses who ask all of us to pay in dollars and safety for their decisions & errors.

Commission members, I urge you to act with courage and with esteem of yourselves & your country & deny this license. Many of us will not have in our lifetimes the opportunity to make such a meaningful stand.
