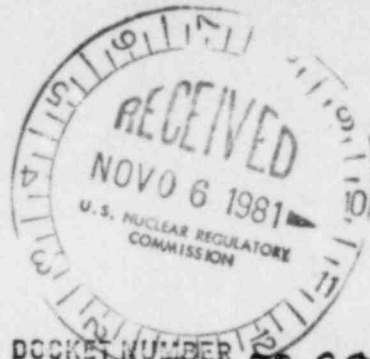

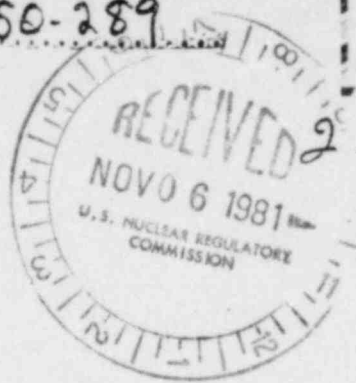

Sir:

I am appalled by your public statement that the NRC would approve the restart of Three Mile Island Unit 1 before the end of this year. Cheating by the workers is a crime and it is compounded by the lack of morality and human compassion of the NRC when its chairman is more concerned with Kilowatts than human life.
