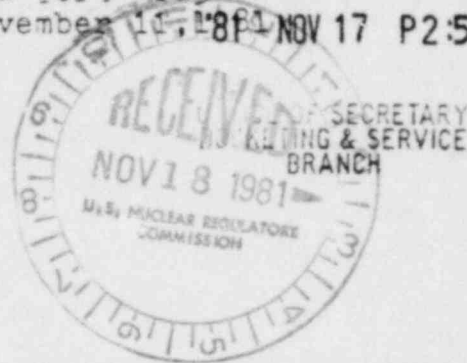

Dear Mr Carter,

I live, with my wife and two young children,  
in Mohegan Lake, Westchester County, about six miles from the  
Indian Point Nuclear Facility.

It has been brought to my attention that hearings  
into the safety of Indian Point 's two functioning plants are  
to be held in the near future.

I am very concerned about these plants. My  
wife was pregnant at the time of the flooding incident at  
Indian Point #2 in October, 1980, and I was madder than hell  
that, even after Three Mile Island, the management saw fit to  
inform me, and my wife, TWO WEEKS after the event had occurred,  
and THREE DAYS after they knew about it. Why should I believe  
anything I hear from the people who operate the plants?

I would like to request the right to make a  
"limited appearance statement", orally, to the review board.

The best time for me would be in the evening  
hours, if that is possible.

Thank you for your help in this matter, and I  
look forward to hearing from you.
