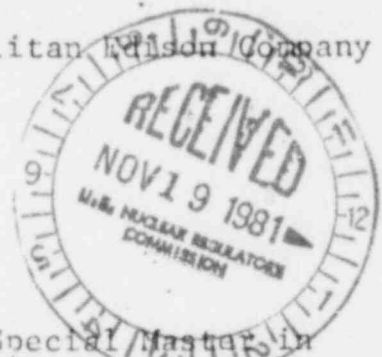

On November 12, 1981, Judge Milhollin, the Special Master in the NRC's reopened proceeding on the restart of TMI-1, issued the enclosed Sequestration Order--which imposes certain obligations upon you as a prospective witness in this proceeding. The Order applies to each individual named or identified by letter designation on Attachment 1 to the Order.

As counsel for Metropolitan Edison Company in this proceeding, I have been requested by Judge Milhollin to serve the Sequestration Order on each individual to whom the Order applies. Additionally, I have been requested by Judge Milhollin to inform each of you that in complying with the Order you should not read those portions of the transcripts of the reopened hearing which include the testimony of any other individual on Attachment 1.

SEQUESTRATION ORDER

It is ordered that no prospective witnesses for the Reopened Hearing on Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1, listed on Attachment 1, shall be present in the hearing room at any time when any other listed prospective witness is testifying: provided, however, that this limitation shall not apply to Robert C. Arnold; and further provided, however, that this limitation shall not apply to John F. Wilson except when Edward V. Trunk is testifying.

It is further ordered that no listed prospective witness shall, prior to or after his testimony, discuss with any other listed prospective witness, either prior to or after such prospective witness' testimony, or with any other Metropolitan Edison Company personnel, the following matters:

1. The nature of the administration (such as instructions given, seating arrangements, and the nature of the proctoring) of the NRC exams

in April 1981 and October 1981, Licensee's Category T, April 1980 and 1981 mocks exams, and makeup exams from the April 1980 and Category T exams; and


2. the oral testimony (including questions asked), given at the Reopened Hearing by any listed prospective witness:

provided, however, that neither of the two limitations listed above shall apply to discussions between any prospective witness and any other prospective witness or any Metropolitan Edison personnel, which discussions are necessary or incidental to the expeditious completion of ordinary business affairs.

It is my intention that immediately after completion of the oral testimony of each listed prospective witness, I shall admonish the witness that he is to abide by the provisions of this Order, and shall answer any questions the witness may have about the Order.

This Order shall become effective as of Nov. 12, 1981 and shall remain in effect until the Record for the Reopened Hearing is closed.
