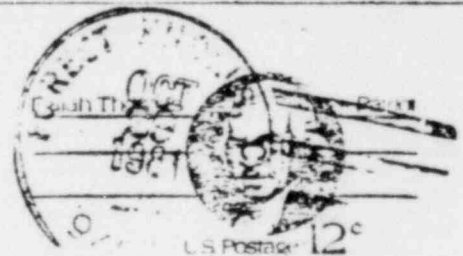


Dear Members of the NRC,
