Dear Ms. Chavez:

This is to confirm our telephone conversation of November 12, 1981. You informed me that my letter of November 10, 1981 accurately reflected our agreements reached on November 5, 1981 regarding DAARE/SAFE's discovery requests directed to Edison.

You also called to suggest that DAARE/SAFE wished to devote its resources to answering Edison's interrogatories of July 8, 1981 before it devotes substantial time to inspecting the voluminous materials which Edison has agreed to make available for your review. You sought assurances that the documents we promised to make available for your inspection and copying in our letter of November 10, 1981 would be available at a later date. I informed you that, subject to our need to have advance notice to permit us to collect the documents in one place, we would make the materials available for your inspection at your convenience. In view of those assurances, you stated that you would not be inspecting documents in our offices on Friday, November 13, 1981 and on Sunday, November 15, 1981 as we had previously arranged at your suggestion.


