Dear Mr. Keimig:

This letter responds to your letter of September 24, 1981 which forwarded the report of the routine inspection of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-95, conducted by Mr. Narrow of your office from September 8-11, 1981. Your letter stated that it appeared that one of our activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements. The apparent noncompliance and our response follow:

Apparent Noncompliance with 10CFR50, Appendix B,  
Criterion V, and the LILCO Quality Assurance Program

Contrary to the above, on September 11, 1981, the inspector observed that Project Procedure P304 does not require report of a possible reportable deficiency.

Corrective Action and Results

Project Office personnel involved in reviewing and reporting deficiencies have been instructed to document and report Potentially Reportable Deficiencies as outlined in the NRC's "Guidance - 10CFR50.55(e), Construction Deficiency Reporting" dated April 1, 1980, and Project Procedure P304 will be modified to incorporate reporting Potentially Reportable Deficiencies as required by the NRC Guidance.

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Steps Taken to Prevent Recurrence

No additional preventive action is considered necessary.

Date Full Compliance Will Be Achieved

Full compliance will be achieved by November 30, 1981.
