Dear Mr. Seyfrit:

Omaha Public Power District's letter to the Commission dated June 26, 1981 stated the District's intent to rearrange the text of the Fort Calhoun Station Emergency Plan into the format of NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1. This revised plan, retitled "Radiological Emergency Response Plan, Omaha Public Power District, Fort Calhoun Station, Revision 0", dated October 15, 1981, was issued as a controlled document on October 22, 1981. In addition to the format changes, the plan incorporates the responses made by the District in its June 26, 1981 letter to the Commission. It also incorporates internal and Commission observations and comments resulting from the full emergency exercise conducted at the Fort Calhoun Station on July 22, 1981.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section IV, Paragraph V, thirteen (13) copies of the reformatted plan are being provided to the Commission under separate cover. Three (3) copies (Numbers 101, 102, and 103) were provided to your office and ten (10) copies (Numbers 104 through 113) were provided to the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation. A transmittal sheet was provided with each copy to confirm receipt of the serialized document. It is requested that these sheets be completed and returned within five (5) days of receipt.

The Radiological Emergency Response Plan, Revision 0, has been fully implemented and is the District's official guidance document for the conduct of emergency preparedness measures at the Fort Calhoun Station. This new plan supersedes the "Fort Calhoun Station Unit No. 1


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Emergency Plan" transmitted to the Commission by letter dated January 2, 1981 and revised by letter dated July 24, 1981. Accordingly, the old plan should be removed from service.
