In reference to a letter dated August 4, 1981, from Mr. T. C. Nichols, Jr. of South Carolina Electric and Gas Company concerning prompt notification of the public, it was stated that a network of sirens would be installed, tested and operable by December, 1981. Due to problems on delivery of parts and scheduling of sound measurement tests on the system the notification system will not be tested and operable by December, 1981.

The notification system will be tested and operable prior to the issuance of an operating license. Both the physical and administrative functions of the notification system will be tested during the operational test of the system.
