Dear Judge Bloch:

This will summarize, at your request, two telephone calls I made to you today.

In response to Decade's discovery requests, I called Peter Anderson today to say that we would be willing to produce the transcript of the October 23-24 meeting of the San Onofre Unit 1 Sleeving Review Board (see my letter of November 24, 1981 to Peter Anderson) pursuant to the Board's ongoing Protective Order in this proceeding. Mr. Anderson said Decade would be willing to receive it under those terms, but a discussion ensued about whether, and to what extent, the proprietary nature of that document could be challenged in this proceeding. The document is not a part of Licensee's application, is not a part of the record of this proceeding, and contains proprietary information from another licensing proceeding involving a licensee (Southern California Edison Company) who is not a party to this proceeding. I called you to report the conversation and alert you that we might require Board resolution of the matter if Licensee and Decade could not come to agreement.



I called Kathleen Falk to inform her that we were sending Decade the document today, by Federal Express, and she agreed that it would be received by Decade pursuant to the Board's on-going Protective Order. If, and to the extent, Decade chooses to challenge the proprietary determinations in that document, any substantive, procedural, and jurisdictional defenses and objections we may have will be raised at that time.

My second call to you today was to report this arrangement. Both of my calls to you were made with Decade's prior knowledge and concurrence.
