Gentlemen:

This letter contains a proposed amendment to the Technical Specifications for Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-35 and NPF-52 for Catawba Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2. This request involves the relocation of Technical Specification Table 3.6-1, Secondary Containment Bypass Leakage Paths, Table 3.6-2a, Unit 1 Containment Isolation Valves, and Table 3.6-2b, Unit 2 Containment Isolation Valves, to Catawba FSAR Chapter 16, Selected Licensee Commitments (SLC) manual. This request also involves clarifications to Technical Specifications 1.7, 4.6.1.1, 3.6.1.2, 3.6.3, 4.6.3.1, 4.6.3.2, and 4.6.3.3 to reflect the relocation of Tables 3.6-1, 3.6-2a, and 3.6-2b to the FSAR. Technical Specification basis Section 3/4.6.4 has been revised to reflect the proposed changes.

Attachment I contains the proposed Technical Specification changes. Attachment II contains the proposed changes to the Catawba FSAR. Attachment III contains a discussion of the justification and no significant hazards analysis. This analysis is included pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91. It has been concluded that the proposed amendment does not involve significant hazards considerations.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91 (b) (1) the appropriate South Carolina State Official is being provided a copy of this amendment request.



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
