Dear Mr. Wood:

This is to advise that, as of April 1, 1990, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation has Nuclear Property and Decontamination insurance in place totaling \$1,875,000,000 as described below.

The primary is provided by ANI/MAELU on a split site basis with \$500,000,000 per plant. The policies covering Nine Mile Unit 1 are ANI 5382 and MAELU TA6197. The Unit 2 policies are ANI 5383 and MAELU TA6198. In the event of common occurrence, there is an aggregate of \$500,000,000 applicable. These policies renew June 1, 1990.

There is Excess Nuclear Property from ANI/MAELU in the amount of \$400,000,000 excess of \$500,000,000. The policy numbers are ANI S89133 and MAELU X89133. These policies renew November 15, 1990.

Also, there is Excess Nuclear Property and Decontamination Liability coverage with Nuclear Electric Insurance Limited (NEIL) in the amount of \$975,000,000 excess of the primary \$500,000,000 from ANI/MAELU under policy number X89-023 which renews November 15, 1990.
