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

5.3.4 At an Alert, and until the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) is activated, the field teams will receive direction from the HPC thru the Dose Assessment Coordinator.


5.3.4.1 Field teams shall establish communications with the TSC Dose Assessment Communicator and receive initial instructions.

5.3.5 At such time that responsibility for dose assessment has been transferred to the EOF, direction of the field teams will be handled by the RAC thru the Field Team Controller.

5.3.5.1 Field teams shall establish communications with the EOF Field Team Communicator.

5.3.6 If radio communications are lost in the field, contact the TSC Dose Assessment Communicator or EOF Field Team Communicator, as applicable, via coin-operated telephone on the PABX line for further instructions:

5.3.7 If communications cannot be established or maintained using any method, return to the Backup OSC and report to the Radiological Controls Coordinator for further instructions (3260 or 3186).
