Gentlemen:

Enclosed you will find the Decommissioning Report for the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station (Shoreham). It has been prepared by the the Long Island Power Authority (LIPA) in consultation with the New York Power Authority (NYPA). Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) provided data and other information for the Decommissioning Report and has reviewed it. The Decommissioning Report is submitted in support of LILCO's pending request for a Defueled<sup>1/</sup> Operating License, filed with the Commission on January 5, 1990.

The Decommissioning Report includes, among its appendices, the following Shoreham-specific documents:



The Decommissioning Report and other enclosed documents do not constitute the decommissioning plan required by 10 CFR §50.82. LILCO believes, however, that these documents furnish an accurate description of the current status of LIPA's planning for the ultimate disposition of Shoreham, and, in combination with the license amendment application transmitted by SNRC-1664, provide an adequate basis for approval of LILCO's pending request for a Defueled Operating License.

LIPA has requested LILCO, as the holder of Shoreham's operating license, to inform the NRC Staff that if the Staff desires to meet at a technical or management level to discuss matters related to the Decommissioning Report, LIPA and its prime contractor for Shoreham, NYPA, would be pleased to participate in such a meeting.

LILCO will soon furnish, under separate cover, a request for NRC approval of the decommissioning funding mechanism established by the Site Cooperation and Reimbursement Agreement between LILCO and LIPA.
