
Gentlemen:

The purpose of this letter is to submit one original and three copies of Revision 16 to the Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) Physical Security Plan, Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Security Training and Qualification Plan. These changes to the security plans are being submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 50.54(p). Revision 16 is being submitted in its entirety due to a format change from the previous revision. Attachment 1 describes the changes being made by this revision. Attachment 2 contains the revised security plans.

Attachment 2 contains Safeguards Information in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21 and therefore should be withheld from public disclosure. This letter and Attachment 1 when separated from Attachment 2 do not contain Safeguards Information and should be handled as decontrolled.

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Change #1

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: Various text pages, Fig. 3.1-3

Reason for Change: These changes correct typographical errors within the security plans.

Justification: The changes are purely editorial in nature, and there is no adverse impact on the plan.

Change #2

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Pages: v, ix

Reason for Change: These changes are necessary to add subheadings into the table of contents which have been omitted in the past.

Justification: The changes only add to the table of contents and not to the plan texts. Thus the effectiveness of the plan is not changed.

Change #3

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 1-2, 1-3

Reason for Change: The change makes administrative revisions to reflect changes in job titles.

Justification: Because the changes involve job titles only, no impact on plan effectiveness is involved. The Superintendent of Plant Support title was changed to Manager Plant Support, and Superintendent of Operations was changed to Manager Operations.

Change #4

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 1-22

Reason for Change: This change clarifies Wolf Creek requirements for Technician training.

Justification: This change clarifies the existing provisions of the plan regarding technician training. Therefore, it does not represent an adverse impact on effectiveness of the plan.

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Change #5

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 1-24, 1-25, 3-32, 3-33

Reason for Change: This change provides administrative revisions to correct referencing errors.

Justification: These changes are editorial in nature and do not affect any commitments in the plan. Thus they do not impact the effectiveness of the plan.

Change #6

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 1-27

Reason for Change: This change clarifies the control of temporary and contractor vehicles. The change clarifies that keys are to be controlled or their control supervised by the responsible foremen.

Justification: The change clarifies the existing vehicle control provisions. Therefore, it does not have any adverse impact on plan effectiveness.

Change #7

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 3-3

Reason for Change: This change provides clarification of a reference.

Justification: The change restates the reference to 10 CFR 73.2 to clarify the particular section referenced. Therefore, it does not change the plan effectiveness.

Change #8

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Page: 3-18

Reason for Change: This change reflects the installation of microwave detectors from a different vendor.

Justification: This change does not change the quality or requirements of the detectors and thus does not affect the plan in an adverse manner.

Change #9

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Pages: 4-2, Fig. 3.1-1, Fig. 4-4

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Reason for Change: This change reflects the renaming and additions of structures.

Justification: The changes affect only the list of structure names and has no adverse impact on the plan.

Change #10

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Pages: 6-1

Reason for Change: This change clarifies the as-built descriptions of the control room and CAS.

Justification: This change describes the as-built configuration of CAS and the control room clarifying these discussions. This change delineates existing configurations and therefore does not adversely impact the effectiveness of the plan.

Change #11

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Pages: 9-2

Reason for Change: This change modifies the requirements for granting temporary unescorted access to the station.

Justification: This change stipulates that from 2/15/90 until 6/15/90 submittal of fingerprint cards to the NRC may be substituted for the existing criminal records check criterion. This change is made in accordance with the guidance provided in Generic Letter 87-10 and discussions with NRC.

Change #12

Document Affected: Physical Security Plan

Pages: Figs. 5.1-1, 5.1-4, 5.1-5, 5.1-6, 5.1-8

Reason for Change: This change added hard keyed locks to existing doors to optimize emergency ingress and egress to specific areas.

Justification: The level of protection to the specific areas have not been changed since no modification to electronic surveillance system is affected. This change has been discussed with the NRC.

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
