Dear Chairman Zech:


Your attention is invited to the Freedom of Information Act, Title 5, U.S. Code, sec. 552, as amended, and to your agency's implementing instructions and regulations, under provisions of which it is requested that I be provided with copies of the following documents from your agency's files and records:

- (1) Correspondence, memoranda and other written documents constituting notification to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission by on-site agency representatives and by representatives of TU Electric Company of the "unusual event" occurring at TU Electric's Comanche Peake nuclear power facility at Glen Rose, Texas, on or about March 12, 1990.
- (2) Correspondence, memoranda and other written documents constituting communications between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and any third party, including but not limited to members of Congress, pertaining directly or indirectly to the "unusual event" at Comanche Peak referenced above.
- (3) NRC regulation and any special directives or instructions pertaining to the reporting of "unusual events" of the type referenced above.

I am willing to provide reimbursement for reasonable reproduction costs. But I request waiver of all fees, under your agency's guidelines, since the documents are requested in connection with research for articles for the Dallas Times Herald, a general circulation daily newspaper, and, as such, their release will primarily benefit the general public.

Thank you for your consideration. I shall look forward to a response at your earliest convenience, but in any event not later than ten (10) days following receipt of this request, as required by law.
