Please be advised that this firm represents H.A.F.A. International, Inc. with regard to the NRC violations that have been attached to the company. Pursuant to the Freedom Information Act, Title 5 of the United States Code Section 552, please find below a detail of the information and documentation that we are requesting on behalf of H.A.F.A. International, Inc. concerning the Nuclear Regulatory Commission investigation that has taken place involving H.A.F.A. International, Inc., and any of the client utilities for whom it performed services.

With regard to the investigation that took place at the Toledo Edison Company, please find below a listing of the documentation and information that we are requesting at this time. For your information, the report number has been designated as 50-346/89021(DRS) and docket number A550-346.

1. All correspondence and interviews by NRC investigators and outside consultants with the two former employees of H.A.F.A. International, Inc. who initially filed complaints with the NRC.
2. Copies of all documented allegations initiated by the two former H.A.F.A. employees, including, but not limited to, the allegations concerning the validity of the alternate testing methods.
3. All information and test data contained in topical report H.A.F.A. 135(p).
4. Copies of all NRC staff memos, notes, interview notes, telephone conversations relating to the investigation performed by the Region III office.

5. Copies of all background information relating to the qualifications of D.W. Jolly, the institute scientist involved in the Toledo Edison investigation.
6. Copies of all allegations made against H.A.F.A. by any individuals not referenced above.
7. Copies of all interviews with the allegeders conducted by the NRC investigation team including individuals that were not employees of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Please be advised that this request is not limited to the above referenced information, but, does also include any and all information relating to the aforementioned investigation.


