The NRC staff agreed in 1985 (Ref. 1), as an interim measure, to consider only the 30-day integrated gamma whole body and beta skin doses to control room personnel, following a design basis loss-of-coolant accident. The staff deferred the thyroid dose determination, pending final review and approval of the iodine source term.

Recently (Ref. 6), the staff informed us that there will be no changes to the iodine source term for operating plants. Further, the staff requested that we evaluate the thyroid dose by May 4, 1990.

Due to the number of submittals (Refs. 2 thru 5) affected by this staff decision, we are requesting an extension of sixty days to complete our evaluation. If you have any questions on this letter, please contact Mr. M. W. Laggart at (201) 316-7968.
