Gentlemen:

Effective April 16, 1990, due to the resignation of Dr. Maw-Suen Ma, LILCO announced the following personnel change:

Mr. Thomas Gillett, the current Radiochemistry/ALARA and Health Physics Section Head of the Nuclear Engineering Department is assigned the position of Manager, Radiological Controls Division.


LILCO has reviewed the change to ensure that qualified personnel continue to carry out the duties and responsibilities of positions described in licensing basis documents such as the SNPS Updated Safety Analysis Report. LILCO concludes, with one exception, that the person designated to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the position described above meets or exceeds the qualification requirements described in the licensing design basis. For the position of Manager, Radiological Controls Division, the designated individual does not fully meet the statement of qualifications in Section 13.1.3.4 of the USAR, since he has not participated in the management activities of an operating nuclear power plant during two months operation above 20% power or a routine refueling outage. Please be advised, however, that LILCO has justifiably reduced this requirement and will be formally notifying the NRC of the change in Revision 3 of the SNPS USAR which is scheduled to be submitted on or before June 1, 1990.

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In accordance with the referenced letters LILCO will maintain Shoreham in a defueled condition until it is transferred to the Long Island Power Authority (LIPA) or until prior approval to refuel the reactor vessel is granted by the NRC. Should this situation change, LILCO will ensure that its qualification commitment for Manager Radiological Controls Division is fulfilled or remains justifiably reduced. Until we are able to transfer Shoreham to LIPA, LILCO concludes that the designated individual can acceptably carry out the duties and responsibilities of this position and that his lack of operating experience, as described above, has no safety significance at Shoreham because the plant will be maintained in a defueled condition.
