Dear Mr. Letourneaut:

By the letter dated November 5, 2019, Up-Side Radiological Services, LLC (USRS) requested written consent by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to a proposed direct transfer of control of NRC Materials License No. 09-29309-01 to Up-Side Management Company, LLC (U-SMC). Based on the information you provided, we understand that USRS, a joint venture between U-SMC and Radiological Survey and Remediation Services, LLS (RSRS) will cease, and U-SMC will be the sole company performing licensed activities. We understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the location of use, materials, persons using licensed material, or persons responsible for radiation safety at the licensed facility. We further understand that the license name will change to Up-Side Management Company, LLC.

Based on the above understandings, as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's safety review of the request, the NRC consents to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the agreement ending the joint venture, and request amending of the license to the new name. Please notify the NRC in writing, if this termination of the joint venture has not been consummated by March 31, 2020, or this consent may be deemed null and void. Future changes in the license's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed locations, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required because this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(21).
